- Prodigy opening up about his past beef with 2 Pac.

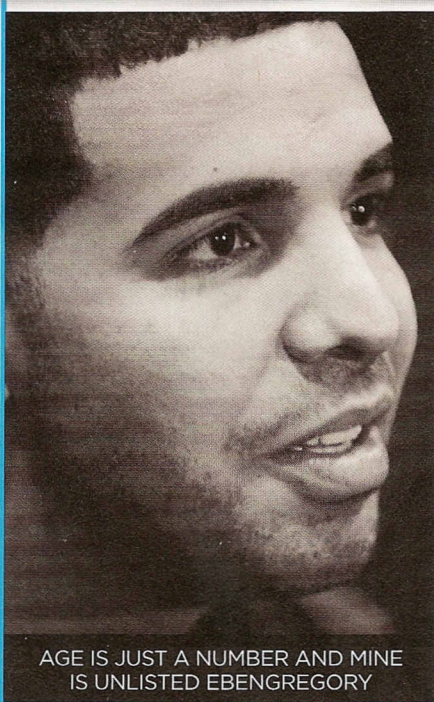
**What EbenGregory Thinks They Mean:** Two wolves battle inside of all of us. One is good the other evil. The one that wins depends on the one we feed.
